# Introduction

First of all, we would like to say that we are very happy that you chose FAUUSP as your academic exchange destination!

In this presentation was made for students who have already been approved for an exchange at FAUUSP.

We will cover some important items that you should be aware of even before arriving in Brazil.

Read carefully, as this may answer some of your questions.





# Academic Calendar

The USP academic year begins at the same time as the regular year, with classes starting in February.

## **The USP calendar of 2024:**

1<sup>o</sup> semestre: 26/Feb to 02/Jul

2<sup>o</sup> semestre: 05/Aug to 12/Dec

# Arrival date

We advise students to plan their arrival in São Paulo 2 or 3 days before the start of classes, so that they can get to know the city of São Paulo a little and settle in more calmly.

Both academic activities and the reception will only take place after the start of the academic semester.

It is important that all students are in São Paulo on the start date of the semester, so that they do not miss any activities.

# Housing in Sao Paulo

USP does not have student housing for exchange students.

So we always recommend that incoming students join the [Whatsapp group](#) to seek information from incoming students who are already here.

**Recommendation 1:** the city of São Paulo is very large, so we suggest that students look for housing close to USP, or to the yellow line subway stations.

Examples of USP near neighborhoods are: Butantã, Pinheiros, Vila Sônia, Vila Yara, etc.

**Recommendation 2:** Rent a room for a month, and during that time talk to your classmates here about housing places they recommend. Or, ask other classmates about the possibility of sharing the rent of an apartment.



# IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

## Visa

Find the Brazilian Consulate/Embassy closest to your city to obtain your study visa.

The acceptance letter sent by our office is your document proving your acceptance to study in Brazil.

## CPF

Now, the CPF can be obtained directly at the Consulate/Embassy.

# FAUUSP Classes

FAU has two courses, and each course has different class times:

## **Architecture and Urbanism:**

08 AM - 06 PM

Lunch time: 12 PM - 02 PM

## **Design:**

07 PM - 10:30 PM

Every USP discipline has a code. FAU disciplines have codes **that start with AU or 16**. Here are some examples:

Disciplines that start in another way are administered by other USP schools.





# FAUUSP Classes

## Grading System

Grades may range from zero to ten, and these numbers may be rounded to the nearest tenth.

In order to pass a course, students must fulfill two conditions:

**minimum score of 5.0 (five) and minimum course attendance of 70%.**

## USP Credits System

For undergraduate students, the credits can be divided into: **Class Credits** (crédito aula), that one credit corresponds to 15 hours/semester of instructional sessions and **Coursework credits** (crédito trabalho): that one credit corresponds to 30 hours/semester of hours of coursework.

**OBS.:** The equivalence of credits is carried out by the institution of origin.



# FAUUSP Classes – Enrollment

## Dates

Enrollment in FAU disciplines will take place from **August 19th to 23rd**.

Place: **Serviço de Graduação** (2nd floor)

Time: **02 PM to 05 PM**

## Schedule planning

Enrollment in disciplines takes place **AFTER** classes begin, so that students can see the discipline syllabus, talk to the professor, check class times and thus be able to plan their semester at FAU in the best possible way.

Use this period to analyze the subjects you are interested in following.



# FAUUSP Classes – TOR

## **Histórico Escolar (Transcript of Records)**

After the end of the semester, the professors begin to enter students' grades and attendance records into the USP system.

Professors have a period of 4 to 5 weeks to complete the upload of the information into the USP system.

After this period, we will be able to send the transcripts of records (or Histórico Escolar).

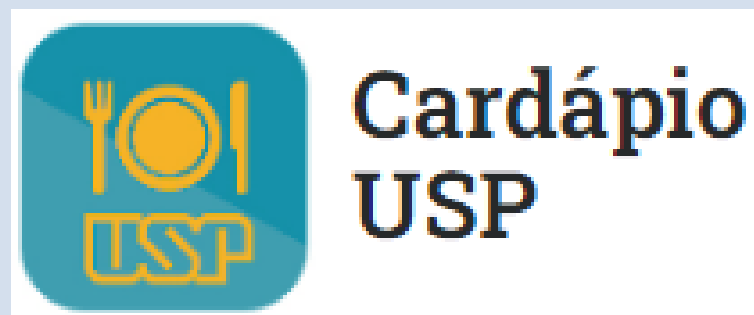
Problems with grades and attendance **should be dealt directly with the professor** of the discipline.
